If there is anything we can do to make your Chapter experience better, please don't hesitate to come see me.



Road Captain Summertime Heat and Your Motorcycle

One of the best ways to keep your motorcycle from overheating?

Allow the engine oil to do its work by idle for a few minutes. It is known as engine warm-up, and doing so will maintain your motorcycle's engine in good shape by allowing the oil to get everywhere it needs to.

Examine the Tires on Your Motorcycle

Keep an eye on your tires. If they're starting to wear thin, there's a big possibility they'll break in high temperatures. As a result, replacing damaged tires as soon as necessary is preferable. Don't forget to consider your tire pressure as well.

Prevent Your Motorcycle from Overheating

Consider a Cooling Fan, and yes, Harley sells them.



Also consider an actual Oil Cooler. It will bring the oil temperature down considerably.



Parking Your Bike in the Shade Is a Good Idea

Take the opportunity to rest your motorcycle in a warm, shaded location. When exposed to high temps like these, it's significantly easier on both you and your bike – not to mention less sun exposure means less paint fading or damage to your components.

Here Comes the Sun....





Here comes the sun, doo-doo-doo-doo... I know you all started singing in your head. Back in 1969, George Harrison was tired of the business that came with being a Beatle so he ditched work

one day and went to hang out with Eric Clapton at his house in the country. After a long cold winter in London, spring was finally showing its beauty with a sunny day and George was inspired to capture the moment in a song that has been a part of our lives ever since. Now living in Southern California is a lot different than living in London. The sun is out year round here, but as we roll into summer that sun intensifies. Protecting yourself from the sun is not only good for your skin but helpful in enjoying life after the ride.

SPF & UPF



Sunscreen allows us to spend more time in the sun while protecting ourselves from the harmful UV rays. We are all familiar with SPF (sun protection factor) but now we are seeing more and more clothing that has UPF (ultraviolet protection factor). SPF 30 sunscreen and UPF 30 clothing will both block out 97% of the harmful UV rays. SPF 50 and UPF 50 will block out 98%. The way it's calculated is 1/30 = 3% of UV rays will pass

through, 1/50 = 2% of UV rays will pass through. When you look at these figures you will see that going above 50 doesn't buy you

much. While sunscreen will wear off after a while and needs to be reapplied if you are spending a lot of time in the sun, the UPF clothing doesn't. A standard t-shirt would have about a UPF 5 rating which allows 20% of UV rays to pass through. So even if you decide to wear a long sleeve t-shirt, you are still being exposed to UV rays. Another option is wearing those pull on sleeves. Most of them are designed with a UPF 30 rating.



I recently purchased a long sleeve sunshirt with a UPF 50 rating to try out. It is light weight, thin, and very comfortable. On the ride to The Melt in La Jolla I wore it under my Harley t-shirt. I didn't put any sunscreen on except for my face. After riding from Temecula to San Marcos, then to La Jolla, and back to Temecula (5 hours in the sun), I had no signs of sun exposure and I didn't feel that physical drain you feel after riding in the sun all day. The day after our Chapter Poker Run I will be taking the family to a water park and trying out another one over the course of the day.




Getting to Know Our Biggs HOG Family 40 members completed the June 2023 Survey

40 members completed the June 2023 Survey Congratulations to Jim W who won the gift card drawing. A new survey opens on the 15th of each month throughout 2023.




Dealer Poker Chips and Dealer Pins




