








I'm happy to announce that Dave "Quip" earned a 100-ride pin last month.

Safety

Know Thyself

In ancient Greece, above the entrance to the Temple of Apollo, the words "Know Thyself" were inscribed. Over the next several hundred years many of the legendary philosophers expounded on this saying and about what they thought it meant. Socrates felt it meant that an unexamined life was not worth living. Plato re-interpreted the saying to mean know your





As riders, I would say that we could take each of those and apply them in one way or another to our enjoyment of being on our motorcycles. Now, I'm no Greek philosopher, but on our recent long distant trip up the California coast I felt the inspiration of this saying.

On Saturday, most of us had spent the day riding up and down along Highway 1. It was great riding weather, nice and cool. As we sat around Saturday night discussing where people wanted to go on Sunday there seemed to be two destinations where people wanted to ride: the James Dean Memorial route and the Mission San Antonio de Padua route. So we decided to ride to breakfast together and split off after Paso Robles. In the morning, Tiki told us that he had combined the best of both routes and, if we wanted, we could all ride together to hit more spots. As we left breakfast we all knew this day would be considerably hotter than the day before as we headed further inland. First stop was the James Dean Memorial about 25 miles east of Paso Robles and as we rolled in, we were all looking for some shade and drinking water. Next stop was back toward Paso Robles to the Estrella Warbirds Museum and Woodland Auto Display before we headed north to the Mission. The timing of this route was chosen because they hold Mass on Sunday mornings at the Mission and we didn't want to get there rolling thunder style and disrupt things. As I got off the bike at the museum, I felt light headed. It was about 95° and I grabbed a cold bottle of water and headed for the AC. Now remember, I live in Temecula and riding in the high 90s is nothing new to me, but that day it was affecting me. We spent some time there cooling down and staying out of the sun and I drank a sports drink for extra hydration. By the time we were ready to push on, I was feeling fine. But there was some talk of heading back to the hotel. So rather than convince myself I would be fine riding in more heat for the next 3-4 hours, I headed back with those who wanted to go back and Tiki led those who wanted to go on to the Mission. I had plenty of water at breakfast, drank a bottle with James Dean, then more at the museum, and had plenty more with me in a cooler. I have no idea how I would have felt if I had pushed on. But I do know that I listened to my body and ended my day safely by the pool with everyone else that day.

Looking Ahead

Hello fellow Biggs HOG Members. I can't believe it's already September. This year has really flown by. Currently, we have 126 members.

I would like to let you all know that Shawn E will be taking over as the Membership Officer in January. I am working with him already to get him up to speed and will assist him through the Membership renewal period. Shawn has eagerly accepted this responsibility, allowing me to move into another position within the Chapter next year.

Looking ahead, we will start accepting membership renewals in November. The goal is to have them all completed no later than the end of January 2024. You can fill out your Membership Application/Waiver form on our website (biggshog.com/members/), print it, sign it, and mail it to Membership at Biggs HOG, PO Box 610, San Marcos, CA 92079, along with your \$25.00 Dues (Cash or Check) or bring it to the November or January Chapter Meeting. We cannot accept emailed waivers; National HOG requires wet signatures on the waivers. You can also bring it to any ride. If you bring it to a ride, and Shawn or I are not there, give it to any Chapter Officer or Road Guard, who will get it to us. Ensure the date on the form is ON or AFTER January 1, 2024. Also, PLEASE print legibly if you fill this out by hand so we can make sure your information is correct in My Chapter Manager (MCM), our membership database. Your email address in MCM is used when eBLASTs are sent out, so we need to make sure it's correct.

Every month, I review National HOG memberships expiring that month, then go into the National HOG database to see if these have been renewed so I can update *MCM*, our Membership Roster and the "Cleared to Ride" list. If you are not a Life National HOG Member and don't want to have the headache of remembering to renew every year, you can set up Auto-Renewal. I do send out email reminders if you let your membership lapse. As a reminder, your National HOG and Biggs Chapter Memberships need to be current, with a current signed waiver on file, in order to ride without filling out a waiver for each ride. When you renew your Biggs HOG Chapter Membership each year and sign the form, you are also signing your waiver which is good for all Chapter-sponsored HOG rides for the year. If you have any questions, please let us know.

So, we still have 4 months of rides left this year. We hope to see you all on these remaining rides. Let's all get out and Ride, Have Fun and Make New Friends!!
