

First Aid Kit

At the September Chapter meeting I went over what items should be included in a First Aid Kit that should be carried on a motorcycle. Here is that list.

- 1 Mini Size Permanent Marker
- 2 Medical Tape
- **1 Compression Tape**
- 1 Pair of Latex Disposable Gloves
- **1 Medical Scissors**
- 1 Emergency Whistle
- 1 Emergency Rescue Blanket
- **1 Antibiotic Ointment**

- 1 Universal Bandage Pack:
 - 6 X Sterile Gauze Pad/Wound Pad
 - **5 Medium Knuckle Bandage**
 - **5 Large Knuckle Bandage**
 - **5 Large Bandage**
 - **5 Medium Bandage**
 - 10 Alcohol Pad

- 1 Windlass Military Tourniquet
- 1 Emergency Trauma Bandage (Pressure Dressing)
- 1 First Aid Manual

2024 Membership Renewals

Hello fellow Biggs HOG family members. I would like to introduce myself to everyone in our Biggs HOG Chapter. As some of you already know, my name is Shawn E, and I will be taking over the Membership Officer position from Taz in 2024. Taz is being considered for the Road



Captain position in 2024, pending approval of the Road Guards, so let's all extend our best wishes to Taz as he pursues this new endeavor. Our current Road Captain, Terry Warner, has admirably served as Road Captain several times over the past 18 years. Let's take a moment to express our gratitude to Terry for his unwavering dedication to our Chapter.

Starting from October 1, 2023, we will be accepting 2024 Biggs HOG Chapter membership renewals. The Chapter Membership Enrollment Form and Release is available at biggshog.com/members or at the membership table at the Chapter Meeting. Annual dues are \$25 per member. It is crucial to note that you must physically sign the Membership Enrollment Form and Release (Waiver) you submit with a date no earlier than January 1, 2024. National HOG does not allow us to accept copies, emails, or facsimile transmissions of this document. Please also ensure your handwriting is legible on the form so we can efficiently transfer your information into our Chapter management software. If you encounter any difficulties with the renewal process, don't hesitate to reach out to Taz or me for assistance.

Our target is to have all members complete their renewals by January 31, 2024. Those who miss this deadline will eventually lose access to the Biggs HOG Private Facebook page and the Chapter e-blasts. They will also need to sign waivers for each ride until they renew. Non-member guests are always welcome to join us on our Chapter rides. All they need to do is sign the appropriate waiver paperwork at the ride brief.

Additionally, we are seeking dedicated Chapter members to become ambassadors, helping with new member orientations and introductions during Chapter meetings. This initiative reflects our commitment at Biggs HOG to create a welcoming environment for new members. If you're interested, please stop by the membership table at the next Chapter Meeting or send Taz or me an email.

Don't forget to stop by the Biggs Service Department and have your mileage recorded so you can earn those Harley gift cards and your National HOG mileage milestone patches. I spoke with a National HOG customer service member, and they recommended that you record your mileage at least twice per calendar year. They recommend recording your mileage on the first day possible in the new year and, minimally, having it recorded again as close to the last day of the year as possible. This will prevent you from losing any miles earned for that calendar year. Only the Biggs Service Department is authorized to record your mileage for submission to National HOG. Again, see Taz or me for more information if you need it.

Oh, The Places You'll Go

Syd and I recently returned from our third and final Long Distance Tour of the year, which is the fifth of six total Overnight/Long Distance trips for 2023. Planning and executing one of these events takes a tremendous amount of time and effort, and all the people who served as



Long Distance Coordinators over the years deserve our unending gratitude. Without them, our LDT motto couldn't be "Miles with Smiles".

So, where have the Biggs HOG LDT Coordinators taken us over the years? We try to keep our Long Distance Trips to around 500 miles from home (and our overnight trips less than that). We also are constrained by geography: we certainly can't travel west 500 miles. I've seen motorcycles and trikes pretty tricked out, but none with an amphibious option. Nor are we able to go south into Mexico under our Biggs HOG banner. That leaves us an arc that runs approximately from Santa Rosa to the north, then eastward through Reno to about Elko, NV, then into Utah to include Bryce Canyon, Zion and Capitol Reef National Parks. Most of Arizona falls within that 500 mile outer limit, ending with Tombstone to our east. You would assume that because of our location, we are at a disadvantage compared to other Chapters (in the Midwest for example) which can travel 500 miles in any direction. But over the years, our amazing Chapter members find new and exciting places to go and things to see.

Over the last decade we've visited Cottonwood, Sedona, Tombstone, Tucson, Williams (Grand Canyon), and Yuma in Arizona. Our most recent Biggs HOG LDT was to Williams AZ – see our adventures elsewhere in this issue.

We've seen Lassen Volcanic National Park, Oxnard, San Luis Obispo, Yosemite, Death Valley, Palm Springs, and Sonora in California. In 2012, the trip to Yosemite included joining up with the California State HOG Rally. In 2022, our Chapter participated in the California Big Trees National HOG Rally, a 9-day event beginning on May 30th and ending on June 8th, leaving from Escondido, traveling first to Bakersfield, then to Eureka before heading home.

Exploring Nevada included trips to Carson City, Las Vegas, Laughlin, and Reno. The latter was most recently part of the 14th annual North Meets South event, a rotating tour where Harley Chapters from Northern Washington to San Diego meet for a weekend of adventures.

Some of our Utah journeys over the years include the Utah Progressive, travels to Zion/Bryce Canyons, and Syd and my first Biggs HOG LDT to Kanab/North Rim. The Utah Progressive in 2016 was a 6-day tour from Escondido to St. George UT, to Torry (Capitol Reef) UT, and finally Cottonwood AZ, before heading for home.

These are just a sample of the LDTs and Overnights throughout the years. Each one is unique, but all leave you with wonderful memories, new friends, and an appreciation for the Biggs HOG family. If you've been with us in the past, I hope this ride down memory lane brings back fond memories. If you're new to our family, I hope this whets your appetite for future trips. To finish Dr. Seuss' quote, "You can steer yourself in any direction you choose. You're on your own and you know what you know, and YOU are the one who'll decide where to go."


