

HOG Ride 365



I don't know about you, but I'm going into withdrawals waiting for the next Long Distant Trip. I enjoy going on our local rides but there's something about getting out on the road for a few days in a row. My favorite Long Distance Ride is the next one. I hope to see many of you out there with us this year.

I hope you've all had time to stop in at the Biggs H-D service counter and have your beginning-of-the-year mileage recorded for HOG Ride 365. If you haven't, get in as soon as you can. The mileage that gets recorded counts toward your *Individual Annual* and *Lifetime Recognitions* and for the *Annual Chapter Challenge*. Your mileage can be from more than one motorcycle as long as they are registered with your HOG ID and you get the beginning and end of year mileage readings. If you are new to HOG or are just not sure what to do, please ask one of the primary officers.



INDIVIDUAL ANNUAL RECOGNITION

The Annual Recognition program rewards members throughout the year for meeting various milestones. Members validate their mileage at a H-D dealership starting January 1 and ending December 31, and then check in frequently to record their miles logged. It's that simple! Here's the Bonus: You will receive a \$50.00 Gift Card after you ride 2,500 miles and a \$100.00 Gift Card after you ride 10,000 miles for the year. Entering your miles often will get you your cash awards sooner.



INDIVIDUAL LIFETIME RECOGNITION

HOG members riding toward the ultimate goal of Lifetime Recognition can apply all the miles logged toward their lifetime goal. HOG will send you a patch (*"patches... we don't need no stinkin' patches"*) at various milestones.



ANNUAL CHAPTER CHALLENGE

The Chapter Challenge makes things even more interesting by adding a competitive element among HOG Chapters. At the end of the year, Chapters with the highest total mileage and highest average mileage per member will be victorious.

FYI, when you buy a used bike, the dealer can't sign you up for HOG Ride 365. They can only sign up bikes with less than 5 miles. I recently got my Road Glide signed up. I called Harley Davidson customer service and got in touch with a HOG benefits representative. I sent her a scanned copy of my title from when I registered it in 2021. It took her a few days but my bike is now registered with the starting mileage that was listed on the title. I then went in on Jan 6th and had the Biggs service department staff read the mileage. And just like that, it added all those missing miles and I just received a new mileage patch and pin in the mail. But, because I put it off for over a year, I did miss out on the gift cards for the miles I rode last year. Not any more!



When We Slow Things Down

SLOW can be just as dangerous as FAST ...

What do I mean by that? Most of us have a more heightened awareness of our surroundings when we are traveling at higher speed. We seem to have a tendency to reduce this



awareness when we are traveling at slower speeds, such as single file on curvy mountain roads. We think it's OK to sightsee at the expense of concentrating on the road ahead. The problem is that at these slower speeds it is much more important to try and maintain that two-second gap. At these slower speeds and on curvy roads, you need to be more conscientious about being in a gear that will provide you with ample power to maneuver around objects. If you are not maintaining an adequate two-second distance to the rider in front of you, you may not have sufficient time to avoid an object or be able to stop in time under control. You may also be forced to make maneuvers you would not normally do if you had adequate distance. This requires practice and concentration on these slow curvy roads and we have a tendency to sightsee over the need for situational awareness.

The following are some techniques to practice for slow speed riding:

PROPER POSTURE

Sit comfortably on the bike and keep your knees against the tank. Try not to move around too much as this transfers weight around and provides steering input to the bike. Keep your feet under you, on the footpegs or floorboards, not the highway pegs.

<u>EYESIGHT</u>

Failure to look ahead is one of the most common errors with slow speed riding. Keeping your eyes up and looking the proper distance ahead gives your mind enough time to plan a route, so you don't have to make so many last-minute corrections. Force yourself to look as far ahead as you can see.

FRONT BRAKES


All things being equal, I would say you should apply both brakes when needing to slow down or stop. At slower speeds, proper application of the front brake is a valuable skill to keep improving on. Applying just a little too much front brake at very slow speeds while the front wheel is turned can pull your bike right to the ground. However, while going through curvy roads at a fairly constant speed, applying just a little front brake as you approach and enter a turn can shift the weight of the bike forward and apply a little more downforce to the front tire thus giving it better traction. This technique is called trail braking. It takes time to develop the skill of gently applying just a little brake and not grabbing a handful.

SLIPPING THE CLUTCH

A great tool to slow speed control is the clutch. Unlike cars with manual transmissions, most motorcycles have wet clutches, which means that the friction plates are bathed in oil to keep them cool. This means that slipping a clutch in and out of the friction zone is not a problem for a short time. When riding at a speed that is slower than your idle will let you go, control your speed by pulling in the clutch past the friction point to disengage the engine from the rear wheel. When you feel unsteady because you are going so slowly you feel you almost have to put your foot down, then let out the clutch a bit to speed up until you're steady. You can do this for quite some time without hurting the clutch.

All Members are enrolled in the *Rider Rewards Program;* I enroll new members as they join our Chapter. 
